Our Early Childhood Center Philosophy

Our Early Childhood Program

Children must be the age of the program they are applying for on or before September 30th of the new school year and must also be potty-trained by the start of school.

- 3 Day Program – Mon., Wed., Fri. (3-year olds only)
- 5 Day Program – Mon. to Fri. (3 and 4-year olds)
- Full day and half day sessions available for all Programs
- Kindergarten (5 years old by Sept. 30th) – 5 Full Days
