- C. This bird starts with the **letter T**. It is a large bird that nests on the ground. Thanksgiving is another clue. _____
- D. This bird starts with the **letter H**. It is a large wading bird with distinctive plumage and a long, sharp bill. _____
- E. This bird starts with the **letter E**. This bird is a large bird of prey. It has a hooked bill and sharp talons. _____
- F. This bird starts with the **letter R**. This is a large, flightless bird from South America.
