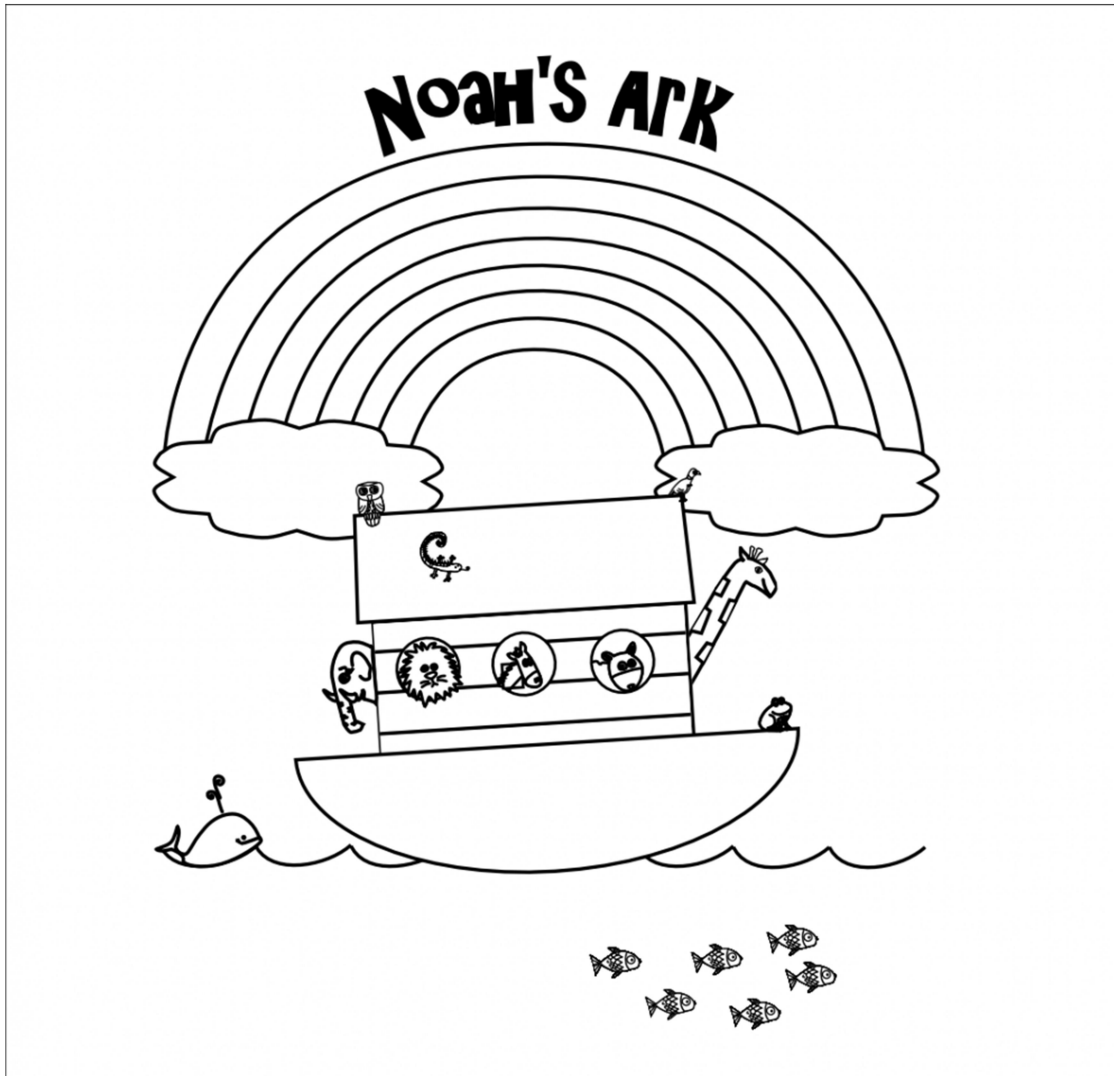
4. In the cartoon, what was the last animal that entered the ark? _____

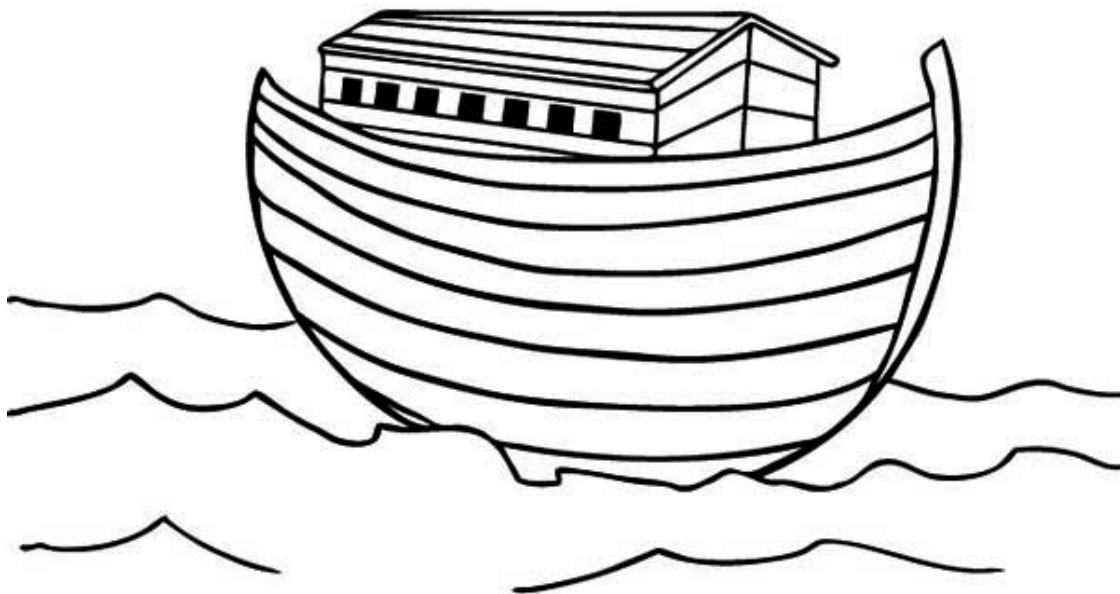
5. Besides the animals and Noah, was there anyone else in the ark during the flood? _____
